The Parliamentary Internship Programme (PIP) is currently accepting applications for the 2016-17 Intern Year (deadline: January 31, 2016). It is an outstanding work-study programme for university graduates in all disciplines.

The Programme offers a paid (\$23,000) 10-month internship that gives Interns the opportunity to work for MPs on both sides of the House of Commons, meet with policy-makers, participate in weekly seminars, produce an original research paper and undertake comparative study tours to legislatures in Canada and abroad. Canadian citizens and permanents residents under 35 years old with a university degree are eligible to apply.

PIP is independent of government and strictly non-partisan. It is an initiative of the Canadian Political Science Association delivered in collaboration with the House of Commons and is supported by public and private sector sponsors including the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council.
